

X Bracelet Purse

materials needed

- 1/4 yard of fabric
- 1/4 yard of batting
- Thread
- 1 bracelet that matches your fabric
- Rotary Tools cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter
- Pine
- Iron
- Water soluble marking pen


cutting instructions

- Cut 2 strips 14" x 20" from your fabric for your purse body and lining.
- Cut 1 strip 3" x 7" from your fabric for the bracelet loop.
- Cut 1 strip 14" x 20" from your batting.


instructions

- *Seam allowance is 1/2" unless otherwise noted.
- 1. Put your two 14" x 20" fabric strips right sides together. Pin them onto the batting.
- 2. Along one side mark two dots 4" apart. Start sewing at one dot all the way around the purse rectangle to the other dot. Make sure you backstitch at the dots and pivot on your corners. Leave the space between the two dots open to turn the purse right side out through.
- 3. Trim your seams to 1/4" and trim your corners on a diagonal. Turn the purse right side out through your opening. Press your purse body well. Turn the seam of the opening to the inside of the purse and pin the opening closed.
- 4. Fold the bottom of the rectangle up 7". Pin the sides together. Set aside.
- 5. Fold your 3" x 7" strip in half with wrong sides together. Press the fold with your iron.



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instructions (cont.)

- 6. Open the strip and fold the two raw edge sides, wrong sides together, to the crease of the first fold. Press the second set of folds.
- 7. Leaving the second set of folds as they are fold along the original fold and match the edges of the second set of folds. Topstitch 1/8" away from each of the folded sides.
- 8. Fold this bracelet loop in half around the bracelet matching the two small unfinished edges. Place the unfinished edge of the bracelet loop into one pinned side of the purse. Pin to hold.
- 9. Starting at the bottom of the purse, topstitch around the entire purse making sure you catch the bracelet loop and close the opening you used to turn the purse right side out.



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
